CONGRESS VENUE

NEW ISAPL STATUTES

The ISAPL statutes were approved by the board meeting, on October 4th, 2012, in Macerata (Italy) and are submitted to members for discussion and referendum at the general meeting to be held in Moscow during 10th International Congress, on June 27, at 6 o'clock PM (18:00).



STATUTES

Approved by the Board on October 4th, 2012, Macerata, Italy.

Article One: General

Section 1. The International Society of Applied Psycholinguistics

(ISAPL) is a nonprofit, nonpolitical and nongovernmental worldwide organization. IALP adopts the policy of non-discrimination with respect to race, national origin, religion,

disabling conditions and gender.

Section 2. The association works for scientific purposes, which brings

persons and institutions in the whole field of Psycholinguistics (General and Applied) and it helps to

promote the field throughout the World.

Section 3. The official languages of the organization are English and

French.

Article two: Organization

Section 1. The legal status is an Association, named the International

Society of Applied Psycholinguistics, abbreviated ISAPL,

and has its legal domicile in Bari, Italy.

Section 2. The organization has a seal which is described in a

separate document.

Section 3. The organization may change its name by a majority vote of

its membership.

Section 4. The constitution of the organization is specified bellow in

respect of its General Assembly (see Article Five), its Board

(see Article Six), its Executive Committee (see Article Seven) and Committee Members (see Article Eight).

Article Three: Purposes

The purposes of this organization are:

- Section 1. To enlarge Psycholinguistics status in the system of sciences, on the basis of the concept of a multidiscipline connected science.
- Section 2. To support general and applied research as well as theoretical and methodological activities.
- Section 3. To promote the teaching of Psycholinguistics and Applied Psycholinguistics.
- Section 4. To strengthen the contact and exchange of information on research and development carried out in the field of General and Applied Psycholinguistics, maintaining and propagating the *ISAPL Bulletin* and also its own site.
- Section 5. To organize regular international meetings, such as, congresses, conferences, seminars and symposia.
- Section 6. To establish contact with scientific organizations concerned with Psycholinguistics and Applied Psycholinguistics and to assist in the establishment of such organizations in countries where such organizations do not exist.
- Section 7. To cooperate with international organizations such as UNESCO, UNICEF, IALP and AILA.

Article Four: Membership

- Section 1. Types of Membership:
- A. Individual Membership Categories:

- 1. *Individual Members*: Any person who teaches, does research or has an activity in Psycholinguistics, or not, but connected with communication, language and language behavior and similar, and who aims at being considered a psycholinguist and/or who wishes to cooperate with ISAPL.
- 2. *Senior Members*: Persons who have been individual members of ISAPL for at least 20 years, have reached 65 years of age, and have requested this designation (membership fee waived).
- 3. *Honored Members*: Persons who have been proposed by a ³/₄ majority of the voting members of the Board and approved by the General Assembly (membership fee waived).

B. Affiliated Society Membership Categories:

- 1. Category A Society Membership: National organizations in Psycholinguistics or Applied Psycholinguistics having individual members among their membership.
- Category B Society Membership: Multinational, regional or local organizations in Psycholinguistics or Applied Psycholinguistics having individual members among their membership.
- Category C Society Membership: Multinational, regional or local organizations in Psycholinguistics or Applied Psycholinguistics comprised of societies as their membership.

C. Affiliated Society Fees (see also Section 3 bellow):

Category A & B are charged on the basis of their number of individual members.

Category C is charged on at a rate that is determined by the Board.

D. Affiliated Society Benefits of Membership

Category A - have voting rights at the General Assembly, the number of delegates proportional to their membership, are entitled to inclusion in affiliated society presentations and events at the Congress, and to reduced fees for their members to attend all ISAPL scientific events.

Category B - are entitled to inclusion in affiliated society presentations and events at the Congress, and to reduced fees for their members to attend all ISAPL scientific events.

Category C - are entitled to inclusion in affiliated society presentations and events at the Congress.

Section 2. Membership process

The admission of a new individual member must be recommended by one individual member or by an affiliated Society of his/her own country. No

recommendation is needed if the applicant is a member of an Affiliated Society Category A or B.

The admission of multinational, regional or local organizations as Affiliated Societies requires the approval of the majority of the ISAPL Board.

Any member may at any time withdraw from the organization or may be suspended or expelled by the Board for any cause prejudicial to the best interests of the organization. Members whose expulsion is being considered by the Board shall be notified of this in writing, and shall have the right to appeal through a duty specified Appeals Procedure.

Section 3. Fees

- a) Annual fees of the Individual Members shall be determined by the General Assembly on proposal of the Board.
- b) The fees of the Affiliated Societies will be determined by the Board.
- c) In case such fees, owing the difficulties of currency regulations of other reasons, that cannot be determined on a general scale, the Executive Committee is empowered to settle the question of fees.
- d) No membership fee will be charged to Honored Members or Senior Members.

Article Five: General Assembly

Section 1. Regular Meetings

The General Assembly shall be held during each Congress. The General shall elect Members of the Board, receive and discuss reports, and decide upon other relevant business.

Written notice thereof shall be sent to each member not fewer than 30 days before the meeting. Such notice shall state the purposes, for which the meeting is called, and the time and the place it is to be held.

Section 2. Special meetings

Special meetings may be called by the Board at any time and shall be called by the Board upon the written request of at least 50 voting members. Notice of special meetings shall be in the same manner as prescribed for the General Assembly.

Section 3. Voting

- a) The Individual Members of the Association and Delegates who have been duly appointed by Category A Affiliated Societies, form the voting body at the General Assembly.
- b) Every individual member and delegate is entitled to one vote. An individual member who is also a delegate is entitled to two votes.
- c) All action shall be decided upon by a majority vote except if otherwise provided in the statutes.

Section 4. Order of Business

The order of business to be followed at the meetings shall be determined by the Board.

Section 5. Election of Board officers and Committee Members

All elections shall take place at the General Assembly or at a special meeting. Individual members unable to attend the General Assembly may apply to the Secretary for voting by electronic or postal mail at least 30 days before the scheduled General Assembly meeting. The votes shall be counted during the General Assembly and added to votes given on site.

Article Six: Board

Section 1 Composition of the Board

The Board is composed by 10 members: An Executive President, called President, Immediate Past President, 4 Vice-Presidents, a Secretary General, a Treasurer, Editor-in-Chief.

The number of voting Board Members shall be eight. The Editor-in-Chief and the Immediate Past President will not have voting rights.

The Board shall supervise the practice of the By-Laws and the Regulations and be responsible for making recommendations for changes.

Section 2. <u>Responsibility</u>

The property and business of the ISAPL organization and management of its affairs shall be vested in the Board, including the appointment of committee chairs and committee members, according to the Regulations. The Board shall fix its policies, hold meetings, organize committees, employ necessary staff, suspend or expel members, authorize proper expenditures, and take all necessary and proper steps to carry out the purposes of the organization and promote its best interests. The Board shall make such rules and regulations covering the details of ISAPL organization and meetings as it determines necessary for the best interests of the association.

Section 3. Terms of Office

At the General Assembly, a new Board shall be elected and serve until the next congress. The term office shall be from one congress to the next, except for the treasurer and the Editor-in-Chief, who will serve from January of the following calendar year.

Section 4. <u>Board powers and duties</u>

The powers and duties of the Board members shall be as follows:

<u>President:</u> The President or his/her designate represents ISAPL internationally. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board and at the General Assembly: s/he shall be the President of the Congresses; s/he appoints all committees with the consent and approval of the Board; s/he shall sign all contracts in the name of the organization; enforce the Statutes. At the General Assembly s/he shall

schedule the presentation of the triennial reports of the Secretary General and Treasurer, and other reports deemed necessary.

Immediate Past

<u>President</u> The Immediate Past President shall perform duties designated by the President and the Board. These duties shall include coordination of the Affiliated Societies. The Immediate Past President shall be non-voting on the Board.

<u>Vice-Presidents</u> The Vice-Presidents shall perform duties designated by the President and the Board, namely, preparations for and arrangements at the Congress which takes place at the completion of their terms of duty according to the existing Regulations.

<u>Secretary General</u> The Secretary General shall serve all notices required by law or the Statutes; s/he shall be responsible for minutes lf açç meetings, conducting the correspondence of the organization; s/he shall keep the membership informed, keep the corporate seal and perform all the customary duties of a secretary.

Treasurer The Treasurer shall receive and deposit in a bank, to be approved by the Board, all the money of the association and keep an accurate account thereof; make special disbursements only upon written authority of the President or the Secretary, sign cheques, make the financial reports of the association and perform all the customary duties of a treasurer.

Section 5. Compensation

No officer of the Board shall receive any salary or compensation, except compensation for disbursement made upon instruction of the Board.

Section 6. Representative

ISAPL judicially and extra-judicially is represented by the Board.

Article 7: Committee

Members

Section 1. Composition of the Committee Members

The Committee Members is composed of 7 members, belonging to different countries.

Section 2. Responsibility

To help the Board, preparing future elections; to enlarge ISAPL membership in their respective countries.

Section 3. Terms of the Committee Members

To ensure continuity, each of the 7 Members of the Committee Members will serve for a term of six years, three and four of them, respectively, being elected at two sequentially General Assemblies.

Article Eight: Advisory Council

Section 1. Composition of the Advisory Council

Three HONORARY PRESIDENTS were nominated from among the first Presidents who were elected for two terms consecutively, in chronological order: T. Slama-Cazacu, R. Titone and L. Scliar-Cabral; two former Presidents and Organizers of 1994 and 1997 Congresses, respectively: S. Stame and M. da G. Pinto.

Section 2. Responsibility

To act as consultants at any Board and Committee Members' demands.

Article Nine: Amendments

These Statutes or any part thereof may be amended, repealed or changed by a 2/3 majority of votes cast at any General Assembly or special meeting called for the purpose, provided, however, that a copy of the proposed change be available to the individual members and Affiliated Societies Category A at least 30 days before the meeting called to consider the same.

Article Ten: Dissolution of ISAPL

If at any time, dissolution of the Association appears to be in the best interest of all concerned, a proposed motion for dissolution of the Association must be circulated to all voting members one year prior to a meeting and approved by at least two-thirds of votes cast. If approved, the liquidation of all assets of the Association will be carried out by the Executive Committee. Decisions of the liquidators shall be final.

APPENDIX 1 [2010: this historical text remains unchanged and will be always part of any updated Statutes, published together with it]

«TEXT presented by Tatiana Slama-Cazacu and Renzo Titone (1982), organizers of **The First International Conference** of the **AILA Commission on Psycholinguistics**, concerning the foundation of the INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF APPLIED PSYCHOLINGUISTICS, ISAPL (Milan, November 1, 1982).

The organizers of **The First International Conference** of the **AILA Commission on Psycholinguistics**, held in MILAN, 1- 3 November, 1982, Prof. T. Slama-Cazacu

and Prof. R. Titone, who are also respectively the President and a Vice-President of the **AILA Commission on Psycholinguistics**, present the following text to the attendance of this Conference:

We have considered, as promoters of both scientific activity in Applied Psycholinguistics and in the **AILA Commission on Psycholinguistics**, that an international association of applied psycholinguistics can be organized today.

The AILA Commission on Psycholinguistics has been a first and useful step toward encouraging research, connections, international meetings and publications in the field, and will continue its activity along the same lines. However, the development of applied psycholinguistics and the present Conference have proven that it is possible and necessary to create an International Association in this field, which will have the following principal aims:

- 1. to stimulate and promote the activity in the domains of teaching psycholinguistics and applied psycholinguistics, of research and publications in these fields;
- 2. to strengthen the contacts and exchange opportunities in the fields;
- **3.** to organize future international meetings with a view to eventually developing even comprehensive congresses, etc.

We shall base our activity on an enlarged concept of "Applied Psycholinguistics", which takes into account not only the field of language and teaching but also other areas such as speech disorders, aspects of mass communication media, interpersonal communication in various social activities (as interaction in labor and classroom contexts, etc.). Participants may offer further suggestions with regard to the objectives of this association.

A first draft of the Association statutes will be written out by T. Slama-Cazacu and R. Titone, and will be submitted for suggestions and approval to the founding committee of ISAPL.

A Founding Committee has supported and prepared this initiative and agreed to nominate the following officials to serve during a transitional period of three years, Those participants in favor of the proposals made above will also be considered as Founding Members of the ISAPL and are asked to write their names and addresses on the founding act of the Association.

ISAPL VOTING GUIDELINES

As you know, much of the important business of the IALP occurs at the General Assembly held at the Congress.

During the next ISAPL Congress to be held on June 26-29, Moscow, the General Assembly will vote on:

- a. the ISAPL Board 2013-2016;
- b. the main theme for the 11th Congress for 2016;
- c. the site of the Congress for 2016.

The voting and ellections take place, according to the new Statutes of ISAPL as follows:

- a. Members. Each individual Member is entitled to one vote. An individual member unable to attend the Congress may apply to the ISAPL Secretary, Diane Ponterotto: dpontero@yahoo.com for voting by e-mail. For voting, each member must be current with their dues of \$ 15 for the triennium.
- b. At the moment we do not have any affiliated society to select delegates to represent them.

Ellection for ISALP Board Membership 2013-2016
